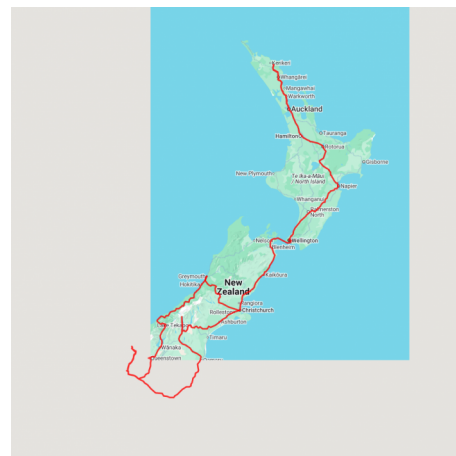

Day 1

Day 2
