Day 1

Day 2

Day 8



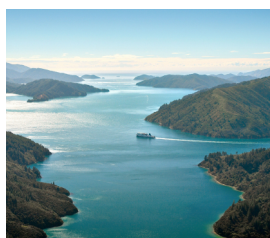
